Know Ye, That, *Jacob Huffstutter assignee*
of Benjamin Boston

having deposited in the General Land Office, a Certificate of the Register
of the Land Office at *Jeffersonville* whereby it appears
that full payment has been made for *the north East quarter*
of section three, in Township Two South,
of Range four East, containing one
hundred and forty nine acres

of the Lands directed to be sold at *Jeffersonville Indiana* by
the Act of Congress, entitled "An Act providing for the sale of the Lands
of the United States, in the Territory north-west of the Ohio, and
above the mouth of Kentucky River," and of the acts amendatory of the
same, *There is Granted,* by the United States, unto the said *Jacob*
Huffstutter and to his heirs the gr lot or section of Land
above described: *To Have and to Hold* the said *quarter* lot
or section of Land, with the Appurtenances, unto the said *Jacob Huff-*
stutter and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
