

Jacobstutter Huxor to J. Huffstutter Dece

This Indenture, Made the twenty eighth day of November One thousand eight hundred and Twenty nides between Jacob Huffstutter and Hannah Huffstutter his wife of Harrison County and State of Indiana of the one part, and John Huffstutter and Nancy Huffstutter his wife of the same County and State of the other part, witnesseth that the said Jacob Huffstutter and Hannah his wife for the consideration of the sum of four hundred Dollars paid to them in hand the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained, sold and confirmed delivered and by these presents do bargain, sell, deliver, alien and confirm unto the said John Huffstutter his heirs and assigns the North East quarter of Section three Township two South of Range four East containing one hundred and forty nine and quarter acres of land unto the said Jacob Huffstutter his heirs and assigns by John Quincy Adams President of the United States bearing date the Twentieth day of August Eighteen Hundred and Twenty Seven.

He have and He hold, alien and confirm with all and every appurtenance appertaining or belonging to the said lot or quarter Section of land and we Jacob Huffstutter and Hannah his wife for ourselves our heirs, executors, administrators or assigns with Covenant and defend the said lot or quarter Section of land unto the said John Huffstutter his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns from any person or persons having any claim or demand against the said premises whatever except what the laws of the State of Indiana lays on.

Be it Remembered that on the 28th day of November in the Year of our Lord 1827 Jacob Huffstutter and Hannah his wife the grantors named in the within said deed appeared before me one of the Justices of the peace for said County and verbally acknowledged the signing and Sealing of the within deed as their act and deed for the purposes therein expressed. And the said Hannah being by me made known to the contents of said deed, and being by me examined separately apart from her said husband declared that she voluntarily & of her own free will and accord without fear or coercion of her husband did and now doth acknowledge the signing and Sealing thereof.
