or personal I also direct that a fair valuation or appraisement be made by three judicious
neighbors of all my said estate ^{exclusive of} my household furniture ^{which shall belong to my wife some}
their names that a copy of the same be given by them to each of my executors I also direct that
all my stock in trade be sold by publick auction and ^{to} that estate of which I shall die
and shall be and forever belong to my wife Sarah S Keen with the exception of the tract
or parcel of land being and lying in the County of Harrison and State of Indiana ^{and} the lands
Said at Jeffersonville and being the South east quarter of the North west quarter of section No
4 Township No 2 South of Range 4 east containing thirty eight acres of which ^{shall} be and
belong to Benton Keen a second son of Matthew M Keen
