 the parties plaintiff and Defendant who was  
 both ready for trial and the Constable  
 returned a pannel of the following Jurors  
 Jesse Weatherly James Frith Ulrich Hon  
 Samuel Sutherlin Anderson Langford George  
 Huffstutter Ezechiel de Duwee Benjamin  
 Stupple Thomas Langford Joseph Arney  
 Benjamin Davis and Samuel Clark p.  
 The plaintiff returned his Demand on an award  
 rendered by Abram Marter and John Ellrod had  
 arbitrators on an object of agreement between  
 the parties and the Defendant pleaded for an award  
 which motion was overruled by the Court  
 and the Jurors being sworn according to Law  
 the following witness was heard in behalf of  
 the Defendant to wit Joseph Dewese leg  
 Jacob Depler John Morgan and John Ellrod  
 and Joseph T. Martin  
 the Jurors then retired
