Now on this 6th day of July 1940, this matter coming on to be heard on the consent of Edith B. Huffstutter and Walter Lloyd Wheeler and the petition of adoption of Ralph G. Huffstutter, and said minor, and the said Ralph G. Huffstutter, Edith B. Huffstutter appearing in open court in person, and Ralph G. Huffstutter and Edith B. Huffstutter having been duly sworn and examined on behalf of the petitioner, said matter was submitted to the court.

On consideration whereof, the court finds that notice of the hearing of the said petition has been duly given as required by the order of this court.

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That said consent and petition are executed as required by the statutes of Nebraska, that the statements set forth in said consent and petition are true, and that it is for the best interests of the said minor that a decree of adoption be entered in accordance with the terms and conditions of said consent and petition.

WHEREFORE, it is ordered, considered and decreed by the court that the said minor be and hereby is fully and legally adopted by the said Ralph G. Huffstutter that said adopting parents and said minor shall hereafter sustain towards each other the usual relation of parent and child; that said minor shall have bestowed upon him equal rights, privileges and immunities of children born in lawful wedlock, and said minor and said adopting parents shall have all the rights and be subject to all the duties of parent and child, and the parents of said minor shall hereafter stand relieved of all parental duties toward, and all responsibility for said minor, and shall have no right over him.

It is further ordered and considered by the court, that said minor shall take and henceforth bear the name of Lloyd C. C. Huffstutter
